COOKIE INFORMATION NOTICE

As Egesil Kimya Sanayi ve Ticaret A.Ş. (“Company”), we use certain cookies during your visit to our website in order to improve your experience. The use of these technologies is carried out in compliance with the Law on the Protection of Personal Data No. 6698 (“Law”) and other applicable legislation.

The purpose of this Cookie Information Notice is to inform you about which types of cookies we use during your visit to our website, for what purposes they are used, and how you can control these cookies.

Our Company may discontinue the use of cookies on our site, change their types or functions, or add new cookies to our site. Therefore, we reserve the right to amend the provisions of this notice at any time. Any changes made to the current text will take effect once published on our website. You can find the last update date at the end of this notice.

Method and Legal Grounds for Collecting Cookies

Cookies are collected automatically in electronic form during your visit to our website, based on the legal ground of our Company’s legitimate interest.

It is important to note that through cookies we only process the IP address information used to connect to our site. No personal data are processed or transferred via cookies on our site.

Which Cookies Are Used and For What Purposes?

On our website, cookies are used for the following purposes:

- Performing essential functions required for the operation of the site
- Bot management and detection of misuse (spam, DDoS, automated traffic)
- Ensuring the security of the website
- Maintaining access for users who have passed security verification
- (Especially when Cloudflare Rate Limiting is used) Ensuring load balancing and secure session management

No personalization, targeting, or advertising cookies are used on our site. Only security cookies are used, specifically Cloudflare cookies, whose servers are located abroad.

How Can I Control the Use of Cookies?

The preferences of our visitors and users regarding the use of cookies and similar technologies are essential to us. However, cookies that are mandatory for the operation of the website must be used. Please note that disabling certain cookies may cause some functions of our site to partially or completely stop working.

What Are Your Rights as a Data Subject?

Under Article 11 of the Law, data subjects whose personal data are processed have the following rights:

- To learn whether personal data are being processed
- To request information if personal data have been processed
- To learn the purpose of processing personal data and whether they are used in accordance with that purpose
- To know the third parties to whom personal data are transferred, whether domestically or abroad
- To request the correction of personal data if they are incomplete or incorrectly processed, and to request that this correction be notified to third parties to whom personal data have been transferred
- To request the deletion or destruction of personal data if the reasons requiring their processing no longer exist, and to request that this deletion or destruction be notified to third parties to whom personal data have been transferred
- To object to the emergence of a result against you by analyzing the processed data exclusively through automated systems

- To request compensation if you suffer damage due to the unlawful processing of personal data

Application Process

You may submit your applications regarding these rights to our Company through the methods specified in the Application Form available at <http://www.egesil.com.tr/>.

Depending on the nature of your request, your applications will be concluded free of charge as soon as possible and within no later than thirty days. However, if the process requires an additional cost, a fee may be charged according to the tariff determined by the Personal Data Protection Board.
