

CUSTOMER / SUPPLIER / BUSINESS PARTNERS INFORMATION NOTICE

In accordance with the Law on the Protection of Personal Data No. 6698 (“Law”), your personal data may be processed by Egesil Kimya San. ve Tic. A.Ş. (“Company”) as the data controller, within the scope explained below.

Purposes of Processing Personal Data

Our Company processes your personal data limited to and proportionate with the following purposes:

- Management of production and operational processes of products and services
- Provision of products and services, execution of sales/purchase processes
- Tracking and management of requests and complaints
- Monitoring of contract processes and legal claims
- Execution of corporate communication activities

Transfer of Processed Personal Data to Whom and for What Purpose

Your personal data, in line with the purposes stated above, may be transferred to legally authorized public institutions and persons, and authorized private persons, upon proper request, within the conditions specified in Articles 8 and 9 of the Law.

Since Microsoft applications and SAP servers used by our Company are located abroad, your personal data may be transferred abroad by ensuring appropriate safeguards and taking necessary technical and administrative measures. Some of your personal data may also be transferred to our group companies due to the use of common departments and company operations.

Additionally, within the scope of export processes, personal data may be transferred to relevant parties abroad, limited to cases where it is mandatory for the fulfillment of contractual obligations. In such transfers, necessary technical and administrative measures are taken in accordance with the legislation, and the transfer is carried out only to the extent required for the performance of the contract.

Method and Legal Grounds for Collecting Personal Data

Your personal data are collected within the scope of benefiting from the services we provide, through channels where you contact us physically face-to-face or electronically. The legal grounds for collection include:

- Explicitly prescribed by law
- Direct necessity for the establishment or performance of a contract
- Mandatory for our Company to fulfill its legal obligations
- Mandatory for the legitimate interests of our Company

Rights of the Data Subject under Article 11 of the Law

As a data subject, you have the following rights under Article 11 of the Law:

- To learn whether your personal data are being processed
- To request information if your personal data have been processed
- To learn the purpose of processing personal data and whether they are used in accordance with that purpose
- To know the third parties to whom personal data are transferred, whether domestically or abroad
- To request the correction of personal data if they are incomplete or incorrectly processed, and to request that this correction be notified to third parties to whom personal data have been transferred
- To request the deletion or destruction of personal data if the reasons requiring their processing no longer exist, and to request that this deletion or destruction be notified to third parties to whom personal data have been transferred
- To object to the emergence of a result against you by analyzing the processed data exclusively through automated systems
- To request compensation if you suffer damage due to the unlawful processing of personal data

Application Process

You may submit your applications regarding these rights to our Company through the methods specified in the Application Form available on our Company's website.

Depending on the nature of your request, your applications will be concluded free of charge as soon as possible and within no later than thirty days. However, if the process requires an additional cost, a fee may be charged according to the tariff determined by the Personal Data Protection Board.
